The organisations for civil protection and disaster relief need volunteers who are willing to take on responsibilities for the state, for example to help in the case of a natural disaster, as a caregiver for people in an emergency situation, as a paramedic at major events or as a trainer for PROTECT.

The voluntary position is not only about giving. You will receive the gratefulness of the people you have assisted. You will be part of a large community of people who take much pleasure in voluntary work and work as a team. Through this, new friendships can develop.

Aid organisations like the Rotes Kreuz, the Malteser Hilfsdienst, the Arbeiter-Samariter-Bund, the Johanniter-Unfall-Hilfe, the Technische Hilfswerk and the Berliner Feuerwehr are also places for learning. They offer interesting educational opportunities which are recognised outside of the voluntary positions and are useful for your personal development.
